Block Captains: Colleen said there is a 37 page Neighborhood Watch Manual that can be downloaded from the RCONA website under Neighborhood Watch. Annette asked about having a meeting with the Roseville Neighborhood Watch Representative, possibly Merv Screeton or Mary Helen Ivers. Annette to attend another Neighborhood Watch meeting. Marilyn to give Annette copies of sign in sheets from National Night Out so she can get her list of block captains started.

Website: Colleen and Marilyn to take a look at the website to try to get it started. Graffiti on Walls and Signs Entering the Neighborhood: There is graffiti on the signs and the walls are covered with odd colors of paint by the City. Per Colleen, the City of Roseville has four colors of paint used to cover graffiti. Colleen to ask the City who is responsible for maintaining the sound walls that run along South Cirby.

Neighborhood Watch Signs: Approximately \$35.00 each, but still need more information about the process. Tabled until the next meeting.

Banking: Colleen informed us the checks we will be using from the bank will be the free ones that we can request 6 printed at a time rather than buying checks for \$14.00 a box. We would only be using a handful of checks. All checks will have two signers.

National Night Out: Notes regarding National Night Out for future reference. We can invite security alarm vendors to our park so neighbors can get information. We can also invite more vendors. We should keep the parking area in front of the pavilion free from cars so the fire engines, police cars and other City of Roseville vehicles can park to allow the children to investigate the service vehicles. Need Solo cups with water to help the scoopers for the ice cream. We bought 4 gallons of ice cream and 132 ice cream cones and we ran out of both at the same time. We also bought ice and 4 24 packs of water. The City donated a case of single

pack mosquito repellent and a bag of outdoor games which are being stored at Marilyn's house.
