Roseville Alerts

If we can't reach you...We can't alert you.

Alert Roseville is a new emergency notification system to alert you about emergencies and other important community news. The system enables officials to provide essential information quickly when there is a threat to the health or safety of you and your family.

In addition to emergency information, you may:

- Select to receive messages regarding road closures or activities that inconvenience the community;
- Choose the locations you want to be contacted about
- such as your parents' home, your workplace and your child's school;
- Receive alerts on your home phone, cell phone, work phone, email, text, or fax.

The success of this service relies on you. The Alert Roseville database currently includes some landline, Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP), and cellular telephone numbers. To ensure that we have your contact information and the preferred method you would like us to contact you, please register at www.roseville.ca.us/AlertRoseville. All information you provide will be kept strictly confidential. You may update your information or opt-out of the system at any time. If you choose to opt-out of Alert Roseville, your information will be erased from the system.

Alert Roseville is a free service provided by the City of Roseville and other participating counties.
