Meeting called to order by President, Stephen Costello, at 7:05 p.m.

Meeting Minutes: Meeting minutes from 8/12/14 were approved.

Treasurer's Report: LaRon Golden reported the beginning balance on August 13, 2014 is \$223.64. A \$75.36 deposit from RCONA for reimbursement of National Night Out expenses and a \$24.83 cash deposit from returned items not used at National Night Out brings our ending balance on September 9, 2014 to \$323.83. A correction to the description of the cash deposit was requested and the treasurer's report will be placed on file.

Reports/Old Business

Roseville Police Officer Neighborhood Report: Officer Rodney Reno filled in for Officer Kate Quartarolo who was not able to attend. While he is not currently working beat 2, he is aware of the ongoing burglaries and excessive soliciting. Officer Reno said that resident tips to the Roseville PD often result in arrests, so he encouraged us to call the non-emergency dispatch at (916) 774-5000 Ext. 1 with concerns. Our recent burglaries and door kicks are occurring during the daytime. The PD currently has 4 unmarked vehicles in beat 2 watching for suspicious activity from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. All permitted solicitors in Roseville must show their permit. You can post a "No Soliciting" sign available from the Roseville PD or print your own from their website under "Forms & Publications". It was recommended not to hire people offering to paint your house number on the curb.

Colleen Cole informed Officer Reno that SCNA has three known homes with either an X or a crescent shape marked on the bottom of their driveways. Officer Reno felt these symbols may have something to do with soliciting codes since we are currently experiencing an increase in solicitation. One of the affected residents suspects these symbols to be codes for a good or bad target for a burglary after doing online research. Colleen asked if she should be informing the Neighborhood Watch block captains of this concern. Officer Reno offered to bring the photos Colleen provided to a department meeting the next day and request someone to get back to Colleen to let her know how Neighborhood Watch should handle this.

Mayor Susan Rohan Offers to Speak at NA Meetings: Joe Dorr reported that as of January, 2015 Carol Garcia will be our new Mayor. A date for inviting the Mayor to speak at a NA meeting would probably be in 2015. Colleen will email Vice Mayor Carol Garcia to see if she would be willing to speak at one of our meetings and if so, what dates she might be available.
