Being A Good Neighbor

Going on a walk with your dog is not only healthy for you and your pooch, but it can also be a great way to meet people in your neighborhood. Of course, you will want to keep some simple rules of etiquette in mind so everyone can love your dog as much as you do.



- Scoop the Poop!** This is especially important for our neighborhood with so many kids running around. Leaving waste is not only messy but dangerous too!
- Use a leash** to prevent harm coming to your dog or to strangers and other animals that might approach your dog. Free play and running should be kept to your own fenced yard or inside home.
- No animals on school grounds** during the days and times school is in session, Mon-Fri 8am - 4pm. Kids tracking in animal waste to class has become a problem and is disruptive to class and embarrassing for the student.
- License your dog** with the City. All dogs over 4 months old must be registered and licensed with the City which is helpful in the event your dog is ever lost.
