Get Rid of Mosquito Breeding Sources

Maintain, manage or eliminate all types of standing water on a regular basis.

- * Drain flower pots
- * Refresh pets' water bowls
- * Dump plant saucers
- * Dump water from toys
- * Store buckets inside
- * Stock ponds with mosquitofish
- * Keep bird baths clean
- * Cover rain barrels
- * Maintain ornamental fountains

Dead birds are some of the earliest indicators that West Nile virus activity is increasing in an area. West Nile virus is primarily a bird disease that is transmitted through mosquito bites.
