Ship to another location such as office or a neighbor who is home Many delivery companies also offer to hold your packages at their respective stores, such as FedEx Office or The UPS Store. Amazon has a similar feature called Amazon Locker (located at Safeway, Cirby and Sunrise), to store your Amazon shipments. Require a signature Track your package
