SCNA Elections – June 11, 2019

One representative or alternate representative from your board attends monthly RCONA meetings. People find them very informative and a great opportunity to share and learn from other NAs. The following positions are available for election: President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and Member-at-Large. Descriptions of typical duties are included in the SCNA bylaws and your current board members can answer any questions you have, including why they chose to get involved.

You may submit names to the Nominations Committee through May 6. No nominations can be accepted after the deadline. All you need to do is email us at info@scna.rcona.com with the name, residence address, email address and phone number of your nominee along with a simple paragraph background biography. If you are submitting someone else's name, please confirm with them their willingness to serve prior to nominating them.

The Slate of Candidates (names and short biographies only) will be posted on our website, scna.rcona.com, by May 11 for our elections on June 11 and will remain posted until after the elections. All residents are encouraged to review the Slate of Candidates and attend the Annual Meeting and Election of Board Members. Only those present at the meeting may vote (no proxy votes or floor nominations allowed).
