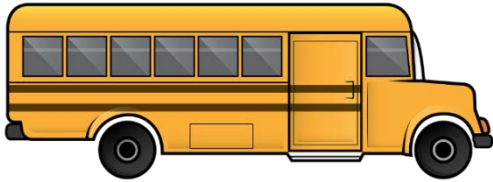
What is SCNA?

Back to School

It's August and that means the start of another school year. With increased traffic around schools, drivers need to take precautions when children are present. Here are a few tips to remember:

- When children are present, school zones require you to obey the posted 25 mph or slower speed limit.
- When a school bus stops with its red lights flashing and/or stop sign extended, you must stop from either direction until all kids are safely across the street and the bus lights stop flashing.
- Be careful at crosswalks. Come to a full stop at stop signs. This will give you ample time to make sure the crosswalk is clear before proceeding. Double check the intersections. Just when you think the coast is clear, a student may appear from nowhere and dart across the street. "...Kids can be unpredictable."
