## Census Day is April 1st

Since 1790, Census Day has been observed nationwide every 10 years. By **April 1st**, every home will receive an invitation to participate in the 2020 Census. There are three options for responding: online, by phone, or by mail. When you respond to the census, you'll tell the Census Bureau where you live as of April 1st, 2020.

The 2020 Census will determine congressional representation, inform how hundreds of billions of dollars in federal funding are allocated, and provide data that will impact communities for the next decade. Learn more at [www.2020census.gov](http://www.2020census.gov).

## Crestmont Park Play Structure
