Roseville Coalition of Neighborhood Associations (RCONA) requires a minimum of four (4) board volunteers to retain "Active Neighborhood Association" status. RCONA provides the insurance for our events, can help with partial funding, and use of City and park facilities. One representative or alternate representative from your board attends RCONA meetings which are informative and a great opportunity to share and learn from other neighborhood associations. Descriptions of typical duties for President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and Member-at-Large are included in the SCNA bylaws. Also, your current board members can answer any questions you have, including why they chose to get involved.

You may submit names to the Nominations Committee through August 24th. No nominations can be accepted after the deadline. All you need to do is email us at <u>southcirbyneighborhoodwatch@gmail.com</u> with the name, residence address, email address and phone number of your nominee along with a simple paragraph background biography. If you are submitting someone else's name, please confirm with them their willingness to serve prior to nominating them.

The Slate of Candidates (names and short biographies only) will be posted on our website, <u>scna.rcona.com</u>, by September 12th for our elections on October 12th and will remain posted until after the elections. All residents are encouraged to review the Slate of Candidates and attend the Annual Meeting and Election of Board Members. Only those present at the meeting may vote (no proxy votes or floor nominations allowed).

The proposed amendment (using the RCONA bylaws template) will be available for your review at the September 14th Board Meeting. The next step is to vote on the amendment at our General Election Meeting.
