What will volunteers do?

- Direct traffic to the actual dumping bins--keep the lines organized.
- Check that participants can show Roseville address identification (driver's license or Roseville utility bill). This event is being paid for by the City of Roseville and only Roseville residents may participate in this service.
- Make sure participants have reviewed the signage posted on-site or flyers/information for items not allowed to drop off.
- When needed, assist with unloading into dumpsters, especially for senior citizens. A volunteer waiver form will be required of all volunteers. All minors must have a waiver form signed by a parent. Request a form by emailing treasurer@rcona.org.

The date is Saturday, April 30th. The shifts are: 8:00 a.m. – 10:30 a.m., 10:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m., or 1:00 p.m. – 3:30 p.m. If a volunteer would like to work multiple shifts, that would be even better! If you can help, please sign up here, [Volunteers: RCONA Spring Cleanup \(signupgenius.com\)](#).

Free Medication Take Back Day

A spring Placer County medication take back day is **Saturday, April 30th**, from 10 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Roseville locations are Oakmont High School, Roseville High School or Sun City Roseville. Gather up your expired and unneeded medications and drop them off for free. Please keep all medications in their original containers. You can leave your personal information on the medications, as everything is incinerated and never removed from the cardboard box they are placed in.

Dangers of Attaching Items to a Utility Pole



A utility pole may seem like a convenient place to hang a poster or a camera, but attaching items to utility poles or street lights can be dangerous and is prohibited in Roseville.

Our line crews work around the clock in all types of weather conditions, and attaching items like homemade signs, banners, and brackets to utility poles can cause serious hazards. If a lineman needs to climb a pole to access overhead equipment for maintenance or to restore power during an outage, these items can become hazardous obstacles. Even something as small as a nail can puncture a lineman's clothes and gloves or snag safety gear, making the lineman vulnerable to falls or possibly electrocution.

Digging into Spring Landscaping Projects

Warmer temperatures and the arrival of spring typically signal the beginning of outdoor projects – everything from installing a mailbox or planting a tree to building a deck or putting in a new fence. Before you start that next project, call 811 to make sure it is safe to dig.



Many utility services are underground – something you wouldn't want to discover by accident. That's why you should contact Underground Service Alert North a minimum of two business days prior to digging. The hotline operates 24 hours a day, seven days a week, 365 days a year.
