Roseville Police Officer Neighborhood Report: Officer Valdivia reported that the prisoner who escaped recently while being treated at a local hospital and while in the custody of the Placer County Sheriff's Department was captured within 24 hours.

Colleen noted that on the corner of Sheridan Ave. and Sheffield Way, drivers often run the stop sign and speed through the area. Additionally, overgrown vegetation blocks a "no outlet" sign. Colleen called Code Enforcement. The City of Roseville will address the overgrown vegetation.

Roseville Fire Neighborhood Report: There was an uptick in illegal fireworks around July 4th and many dry grass fires in West Roseville. There were no house fires or serious injuries.

National Night Out: The ad hoc planning committee met. Most items needed to participate have been completed. Stephanie reported that her son's baseball team will help serve food and drinks. Entertainment and music options are still being worked out. SCNA board members should arrive at 5 p.m. to help set up.
