Descriptions of typical duties for President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and Member-at-Large are included in the SCNA bylaws. Your current board members can answer any questions you have, including why they chose to get involved.

You may submit names to the Nominations Committee through September 25th. No nominations can be accepted after the deadline.
